EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27 Series of 2020

AN ORDER ALLOWING THE REGULATED OPERATION OF TRICYCLES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF MEYCAUAYAN DURING THE MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 18, S. 2020 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued *Proclamation No. 922*, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the outbreak of COVID-19, this being an emergency threatening national security;

WHEREAS, *Resolution No. 55-A, Series of 2020* of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) placed the Province of Bulacan under **Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ)** observing strict local action until 31 July 2020;

WHEREAS, all the local government units are enjoined to issue the necessary executive orders consistent with the provisions of the IATF-MEID Omnibus Guidelines for implementation in their respective territorial jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 18, Series of 2020 issued by Governor Daniel R. Fernando, operation of public utility tricycles may be allowed by the cities and municipalities subject to the one-passenger limit without a backrider, and in accordance with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) guidelines;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of order in the community, guidelines and protocols should be created during the effectivity and implementation of the MGCQ in the City of Meycauayan;

WHEREAS, RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and RA 9356, also known as the Charter of the City of Meycauayan, authorize the City Mayor to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me by law, I, **LINABELLE RUTH R. VILLARICA**, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 18, SERIES OF 2020.
Section 1(D) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. In accordance with Resolution No. 55-A, Series of 2020, Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with Amendments as of July 02, 2020, DILG, and DOTr guidelines, tricycle operations in the

City of Meycauayan shall be allowed, subject to the following restrictions and conditions:

D. Schedule of Operations

1. Odd-Even Number Scheme is hereby lifted for the duration of the MGCQ within the City of Meycauayan.
2. Tricycles are only allowed to operate from five o'clock in the morning (5:00 AM) up to seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 PM).

SECTION 2. UNAFFECTED PROVISIONS. Except for the foregoing amendments, all other provisions of *Executive Order No. 18, Series of 2020* shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this Order be declared unconstitutional or inconsistent with law, the other remaining parts thereof shall remain valid in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately. Any previous order inconsistent herewith shall be deemed repealed.
