CITY RESOLUTION NO. 2020-079

***A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF DEADLINE
FOR THE PAYMENT OF LOCAL BUSINESS TAX DUE ON APRIL 20, 2020 UNTIL
JUNE 30, 2020 IN THE CITY OF MEYCAUAYAN, BULACAN.***

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”, states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Duterte, on March 16, 2020, placed the entire Luzon mainland under an Enhanced Community Quarantine following the rise of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) cases in the country which means stringent travel restrictions, no mass transportation and suspension of work except for health workers, skeletal forces in business outsourcing companies and export-oriented industries, accredited media workers, employees of supermarkets, banks and other establishments that provide basic commodities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the issuance of a Memorandum Circular on Community Quarantine over the entire Luzon and further guidelines for the management of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) situation, City Mayor - Linabelle Ruth R. Villarica implemented a work from home arrangement in the City Government of Meycauayan through Memorandum No. 051-2020 dated March 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, the observance of a strict home quarantine in all households and the limiting of movement to access of basic necessities would make it difficult for taxpayers especially those residing in other areas to meet the prescribed deadline of payment;


WHEREAS, extending the payment period of Local Business Taxes will provide residents more time to settle their dues without penalty and would be a means of showing our assistance to the public that is severely affected by the COVID-19 threat in the country;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED,** as it is hereby **RESOLVED,** that this Sangguniang Panlungsod hereby **AUTHORIZES** the **EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF LOCAL BUSINESS TAX DUE ON APRIL 20, 2020 UNTIL JUNE 30, 2020 IN THE CITY OF MEYCAUAYAN, BULACAN.**


RESOLVED FINALLY, let copies of this Resolution be sent to all Offices concerned for their information and guidance.


